- Focus on the main task of helping you to transfer a Statement of SEN or Learning Difficulty Assessment (LDA) to an EHC Plan (transfer review)
- Help you to put together the one page profile for your child or young person
- Provide you with information to help you understand personal budgets
- Request a new assessment
- Help you to understand the local referral process and Local Offer
- Signpost you to the Information Advice and Support Service (IASS) when the issue is outside our remit
