

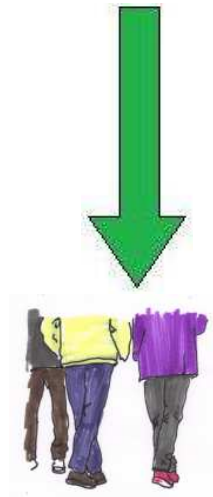
Travel and Directions – Bromley Civic Centre

Train:

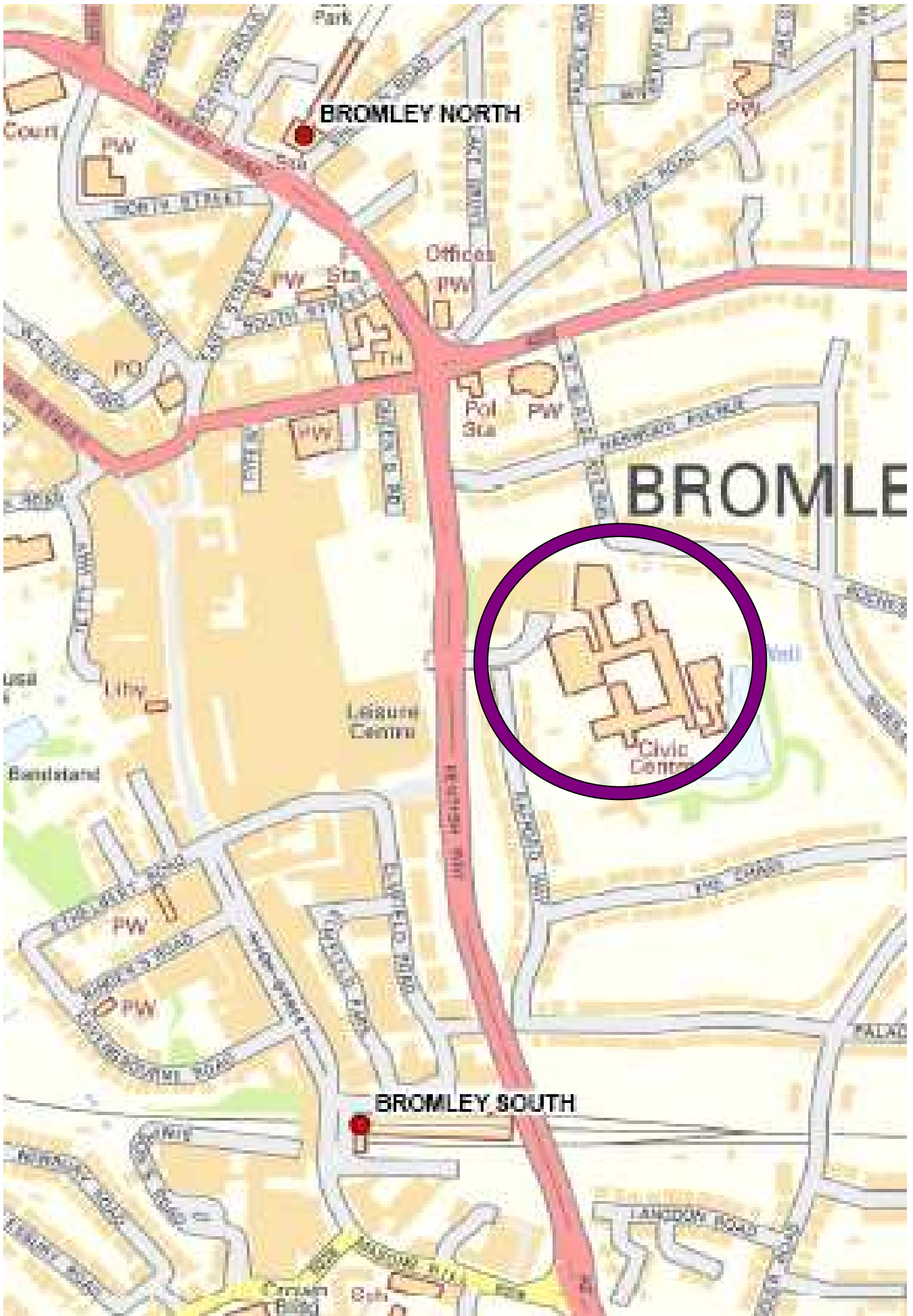
The Civic Centre is a 10 minute walk from both Bromley South and Bromley North train stations. Neither of these stations has level access or is wheelchair accessible.

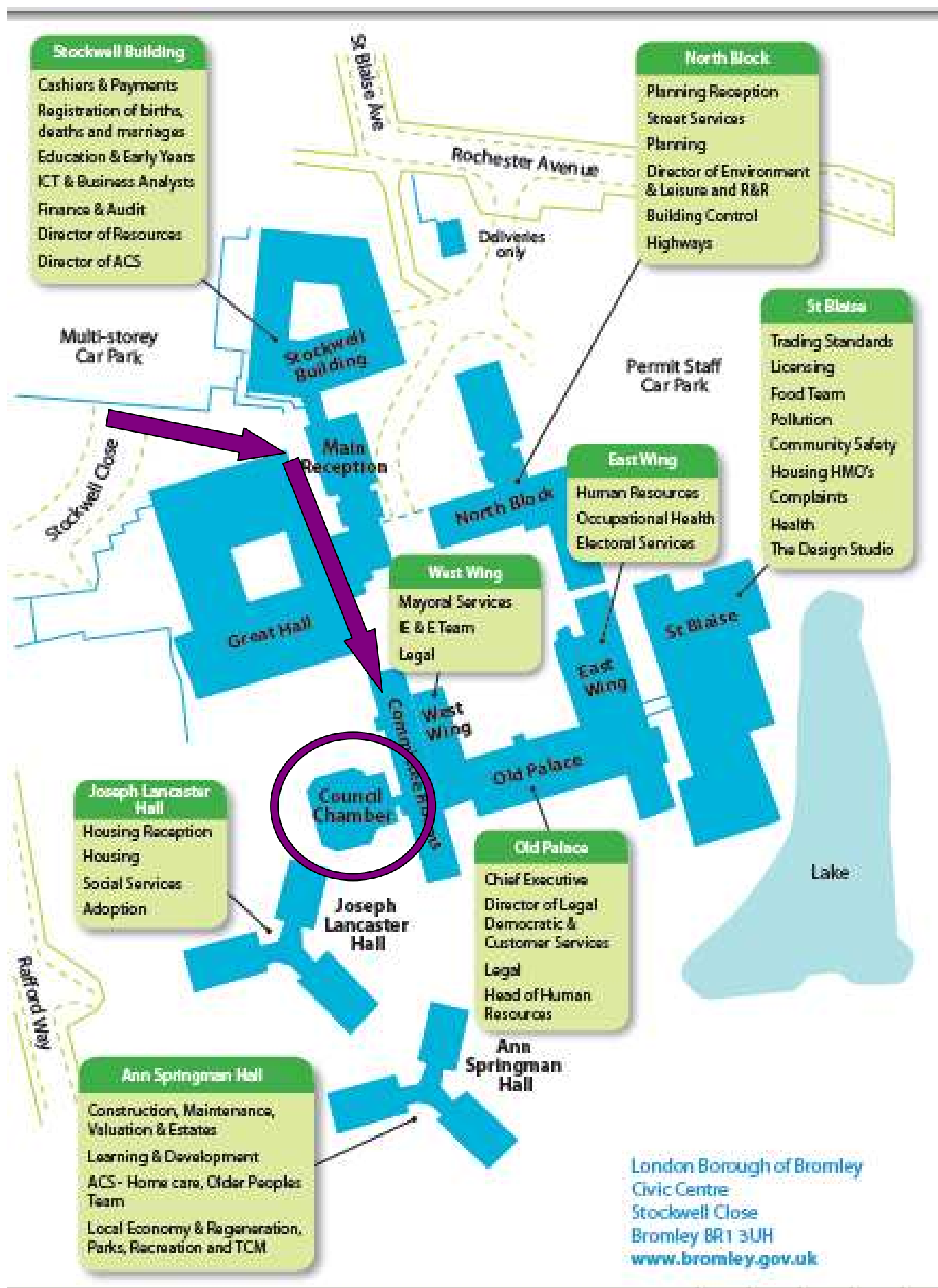


Parking:
