O je and Tabhir Aire – Take care

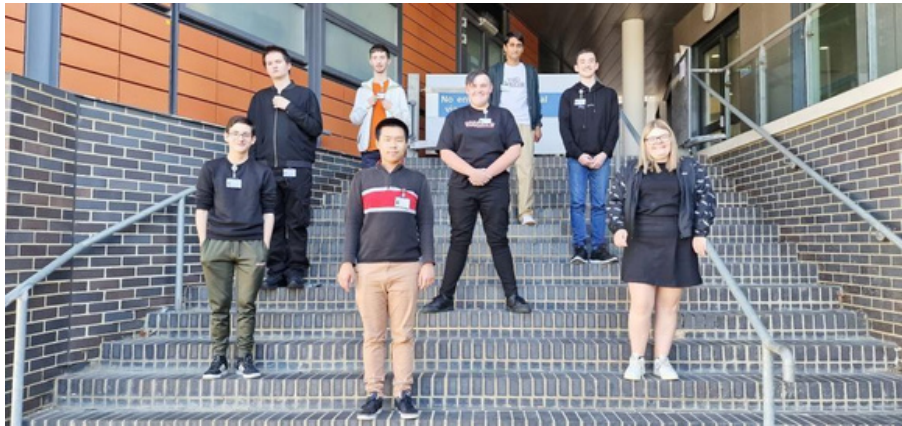

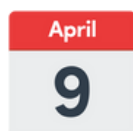
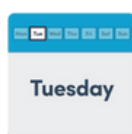

Soft drinks will be available free of charge.

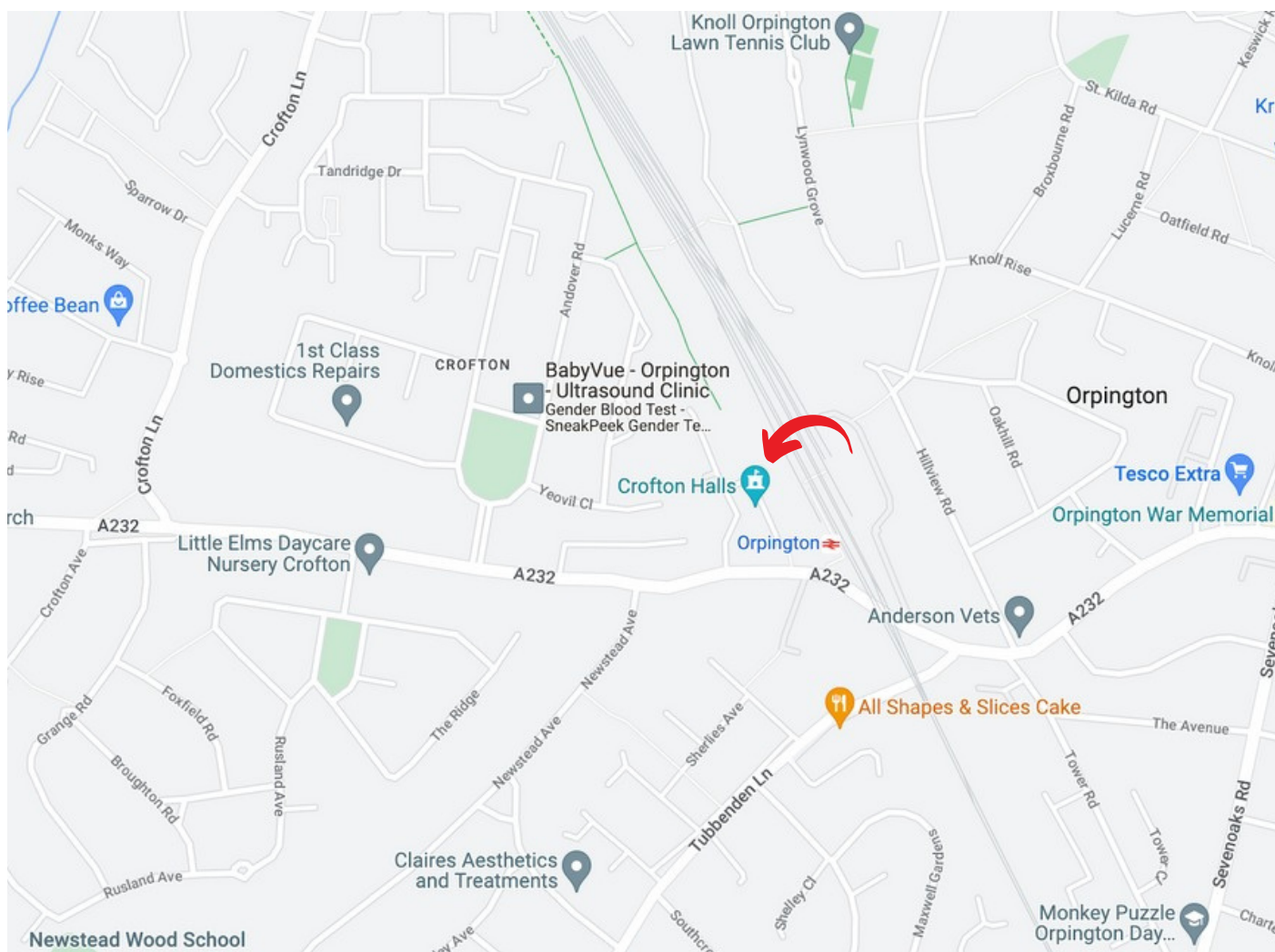
Map and directions
