We have been awarded two grants from the Jack Petchey Foundation.

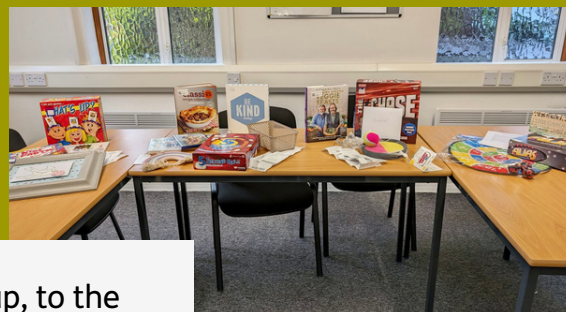
A £300.00 environmental grant which has been put towards purchasing further resources for our outdoor garden area.

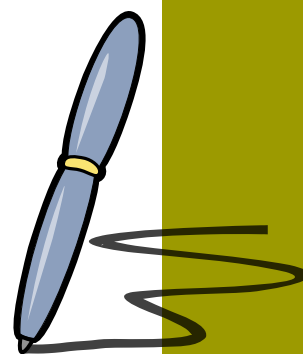

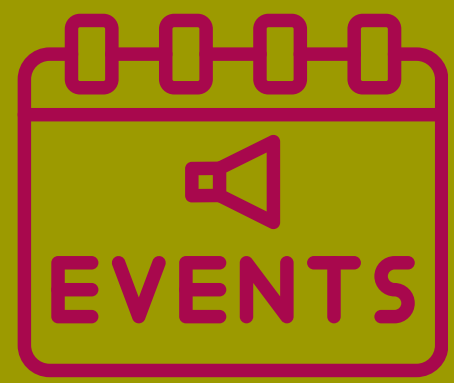
