- 6th January 2025: PD Day - Training Centre is closed.

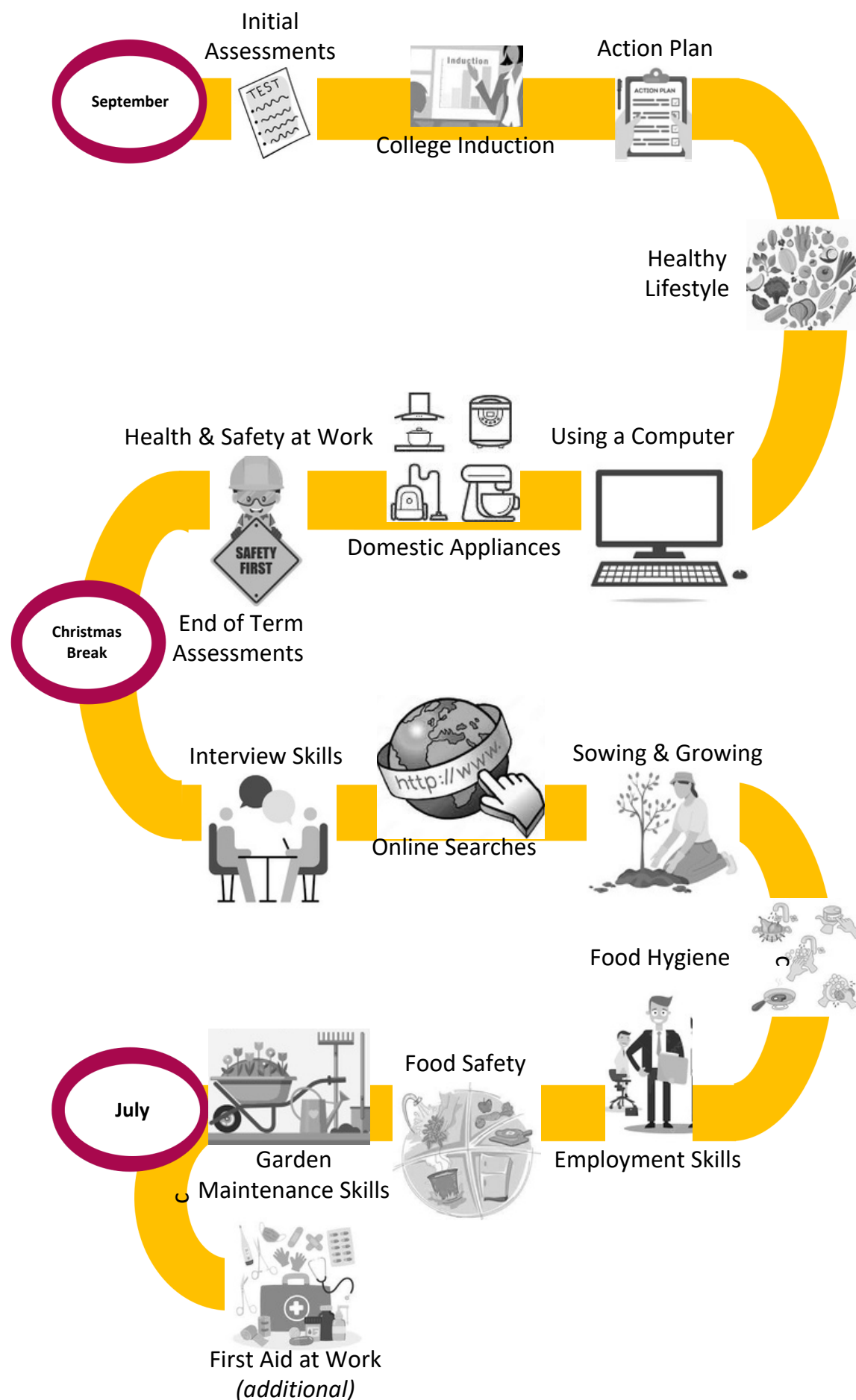
