Bromley Mencap Training Centre Safeguarding Statement

Bromley Mencap Training Centre is an education provision within Bromley Mencap which is for learners with Special Educational Needs and Education, Health and Care Plans who may be between the ages of 16 and 25.

Bromley Mencap recognises the statutory responsibility to safeguard and promote the welfare of all vulnerable young people, both internally and outside of the Training Centre setting. With this Bromley Mencap note the wider compliance and duties required for education provided this includes and not limited to:

- Keeping Children Safe in Education 2023 (KCSIE)
- Working Together to Safeguard Children 2023 (WTSC)
- Ofsted: Education Inspection Framework 2023
- Framework for the Assessment of Children in Need 2000
- Early Years and Foundation Stage Framework 2021 (EYFS)
- The Education Act 2002
- The Education and Inspections Act 2006
- The Non-Maintained Special Schools (England) Regulations 2015

All staff working at the Training Centre have undergone enhanced DBS checks as part of the recruitment process. All staff will complete appropriate safeguarding and prevent/radicalisation, yearly refresher training or review will take place for the KCSIE. Staff ratios will be maintained at all times.

There will always be a Designated Safeguarding Lead on site at the Training Centre throughout the timetabled day to respond to concerns and liaise with the lead Bromley Mencap Designated Safeguarding Lead.

The Designated Safeguarding Lead will be a trained Mental Health First Aider (MHFA) to further enhance the welfare and well-being support provided within the provision.

All learners undergo an induction which covers safeguarding and welfare information. Posters are displayed around the Training Centre which indicate who can be approached.

Online safety and personal safety topics are embedded into the curriculum and wider learning delivered to learners.

All visitors to the Training Centre will be asked to sign-in and will be signified by a visitor lanyard.
