Learning with purpose

Everything we teach has one purpose: Preparing young people for life beyond education. Rather than teaching skills in isolation, we create opportunities for learners to apply them in meaningful, real-world situations. Our curriculum combines nationally recognised qualifications with practical experiences that build confidence, independence and employability.

Year One: Building Foundations

OCN London Entry Level 3 Certificate in Independence and Employability

The programme is designed to help learners develop the knowledge, skills and confidence needed for adult life through a personalised curriculum that includes:

Preparing for Adulthood

Enterprise & Work-Related Learning

Throughout the year, learners apply these skills through practical activities, community learning and real-life experiences.



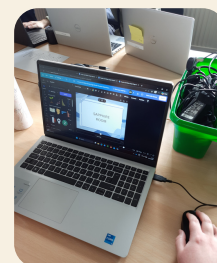
Year Two: Preparing for What's Next

OCN London Level 1 Certificate in Skills for Vocational Studies

Learners continue to develop their skills through a personalised programme with increased emphasis on employability, work experience and progression.

Learners have opportunities to:

- Complete meaningful work experience
- Gain an accredited Barista Skills qualification
- Develop workplace skills through our Enterprise Cafe
- Apply Digital Skills through real office administration
- Take part in Springpod virtual work experience
- Volunteer through Grounds for Growth and other community opportunities
- Prepare for employment, supported internships or further education



As learners grow in confidence, support is gradually reduced where appropriate, helping them become increasingly independent and ready for their next steps.

Transition Support

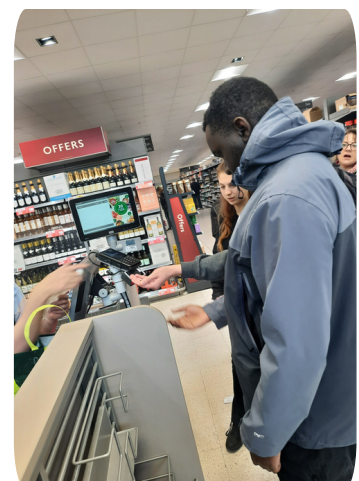
A dedicated professional available five days a week to support Year two learners to plan their next steps and move on from BMTC.

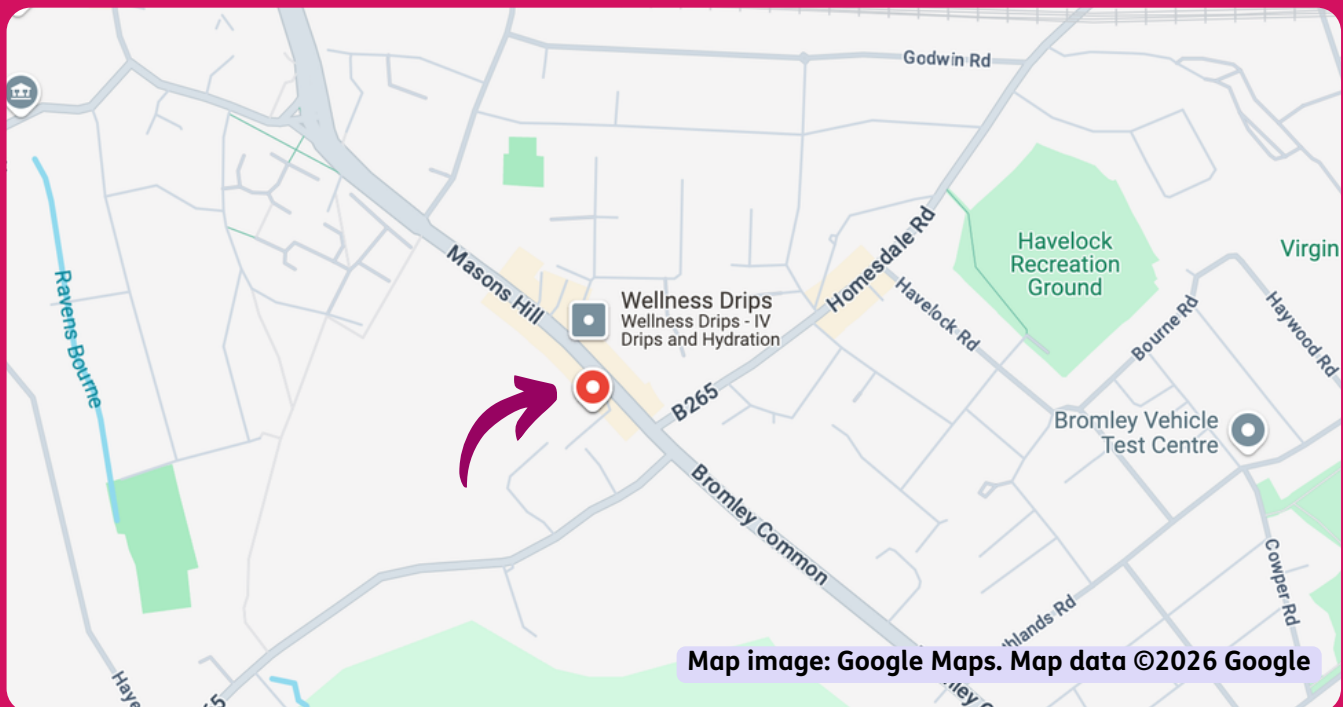
How to find us

 **Bromley Mencap Training Centre,
Rutland House, 44 Masons Hill,

We are located at the rear of the Bromcom building.



To find us on foot, walk through the alleyway on the right-hand side and continue to the back of the building, where you'll see the entrance to our training centre.



By Car

Turn left at the front of the building and drive into the car park. The entrance to the Training Centre will be visible. There are drop-off spaces available, but please note that there is no parking for learners on site.

By Bus

Masons Hill is just outside Bromley town centre and on the main A21 bus route. Buses 61, 208, 261, 320, 336, 358 stop close by.
