accessible information**

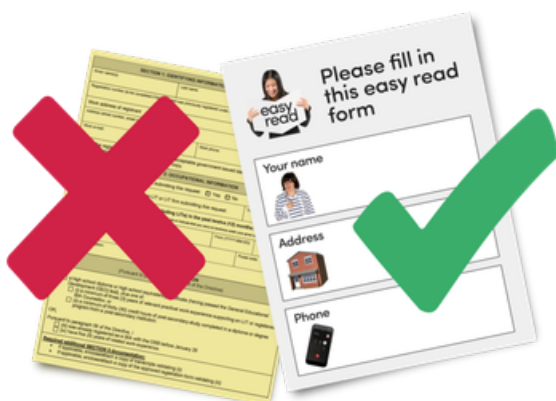


Royal Mencap wants to hear from people with a learning disability about accessible information.

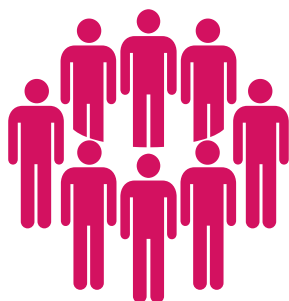
